WORK SESSION ITEMS

Role of the Commission and Review of Current Parks & Recreation Commission Goals. Presentation by Robert Mijares, Parks and Recreation Commission Chairman (30 minutes).

Robert Mijares, Commission Chairman, reviewed the role of the Commission, and each Commission member expanded on one of the Commission's goals for 2010-12: 1) advocate for healthy lifestyles; 2) community sense of place; 3) Advocate "green" sustainability; 4) Collaborate with other public entities and groups; 5) advocate for city recognition.

Vince Elizondo, Parks & Recreation Director, discussed emerging trends and issues, including volunteerism, expanding financial opportunities, partnerships and collaboration, and park security and safety.

- Jim Bean, Parks & Urban Forestry Division, presented an update on operations and maintenance including sub-contracted services, park ranger services, urban forestry program, volunteer projects, playground replacements, new parks, renovated parking lots, trails and other amenities.

Track 4

Jeannie Greenwood, Recreation Manager, discussed the programs of the Recreation division and introduced recreation staff members. The Recreation Division is responsible for adult sports, youth sports, athletic facility management, aquatics, special event, senior services, youth and teens, tiny tots, and marketing. Greenwood reviewed the variety of sports programs available in the City and the number of participants during 2010.

Council discussed the ridership of the Loop Bus and also the status of the BMX Park. Greenwood responded to council questions.

<u>Closing Comments -</u> Vice Mayor Shuklian recommended another joint meeting with the Parks and Recreation Commissioners regarding the General Plan Update. Mayor Link encouraged the Commissioners to attend the public meetings in July regarding the General Plan Update to discuss where future parks will be in the City of Visalia. Councilmember Nelsen encouraged volunteerism.
