**Details:** On 08/01/13 at about 2037 hours, Officers of the Visalia Police Department responded to a reported burglary in the 2100 block of N. Zachary. A citizen in the area had observed what they believed to be an unknown male subject who had just burglarized a home on Zachary. Officers investigating the crime scene confirmed that a residential burglary had occurred. The home owners, who were not home, were contacted to catalog property taken from the residence. The citizen witness was able to provide a description of the suspect vehicle. During this same time frame another vigilant citizen had observed the suspect vehicle in the area and had reported suspicious behavior. Based on both witness account information detectives of the Property Crimes Unit were able to piece together information leading to the location of the suspect vehicle in the City of Visalia. During a search of the residence where the vehicle was located, the stolen property from the residential burglary was located and a male subject from the residence was taken into custody for the burglary. The suspect Angel P. Corrales, was arrested and booked into the Tulare County Main Jail on charges of Residential Burglary. The property recovered was returned to the victim.
