Details: The Visalia Police Department was contacted on 8/9/13 by a male victim reporting he paid for San Francisco 49er football tickets listed on Craigslist and later discovered the tickets were reported stolen to the stadium and not valid. The male victim reported he purchased several different game tickets from S/Robin Doran who had posted the Craigslist ad for the season tickets.

An investigation into the theft and sale of the tickets began where detectives discovered the 2013 tickets had been stolen from a second victim's residence in Visalia by S/Martinez. The value of the stolen tickets was \$2,960 plus an undetermined value of the commemorative items included with the tickets.

On 8/14/13 members of the Visalia Police Department contacted S/Doran who sold additional stolen 49er tickets to an undercover officer. S/Doran and S/Martinez were taken into custody from their residence in the 1400 block of N. Oak Park. The investigation is continuing for additional tickets sold by the suspects.
