**Details:** On listed date and time, Officers responded to Sally's Beauty Supply in regards to a burglary in progress. A witness recorded the suspect vehicle on there cell phone as it fled prior to Officers arrival. Through an investigation the listed suspect was linked to the burglary. On 10/10/13 Detectives obtained information that the suspect was possibly in the City of Coalinga. Visalia PD Detectives Spotted Michael Bradsteen in a passenger vehicle, and a traffice stop was conducted. The suspect was taken into custody with the assistance of Coalinga Police Department after a brief foot pursuit. Michael Bradsteen was transported back to Tulare County Jail where he was booked for commercial burglary, comitting a felony while out on bail, and five additional arrest warrants. The investigation is ongoing.
