Details: On 11/6/13 at 2355 hours; Patrol Officers respond to the 3700 Block of W. Prospect regarding a theft in progress. Officers learn that (S) Nuno had been in that area on a bicycle and had reached into a locked vehicle through a partially closed window and unlocked the door. (S) Nuno then stole clothing and other items from the vehicle and set off the car alarm when opening the door. Nuno was chased down and detained by the owner who heard the alarm sounding. As officers investigated the case, the bicycle ridden by Nuno was determined to be stolen during a residential burglary earlier in the evening. The bicycle was confirmed to be stolen from the 3000 Block of W. Hyde during a residential burglary at 2215 hours the same night. All property was returned to the owners and Nuno was booked into Tulare County Main Jail on theft and burglary charges.
