Details: On 01/17/14 at 1002 Hours, Visalia PD received a call that an interrupted residential burglary had just occurred at the listed location. The victim said he arrived at the residence and found two unknown suspects exiting the residence and their vehicle parked in the driveway. The victim attempted to block in the suspect vehicle with his personal vehicle. When the suspects attempted to drive away, through the front yard, the victim again tried to block them in. The suspect vehicle and victim vehicle had a minor collision as the suspects fled. The victim followed the suspects, both in their own vehicles, for several blocks. The suspects parked their vehicle and fled on foot in the area of Encina St and Kaweah Ave.

Officers from Visalia PD patrol, Motors, Youth Services, Violent Crimes, Property Crimes, TRATT, and TARGET, responded to the area and set a perimeter. During a subsequent search of the area, the listed suspect was located. He was positively identified as being involved in the residential burglary. The second suspect is still outstanding and has not been identified. No property is outstanding. The suspect was booked into Tulare County Jail for Residential Burglary (459 PC) and Vandalism (594 PC).
