Details: On January 31, 2014, at 1215 hours members of the Tulare County Sheriff's Department, Alcoholic Beverage Control and the Visalia Police Department responded to the Gonzalez Meat Market at 15907 Avenue 328 in Ivanhoe after receiving reports that illegal gambling was taken place at the location. Investigating units located two slot machines and other gambling indicia inside of the business. The listed suspect was arrested and released with a cite to appear. Approximately \$ 2,400 in cash was seized from inside of the two slot machines.
