**Details:** On the above listed date and time, officers were sent to the area of Jennie and College for a brandishing of a firearm that had just occurred. The reporting party advised a group of males had brandished a handgun at him as they walked by his vehicle. He said the males were walking southbound. As officers arrived in the area, the males ran into a backyard where they were detained. Another victim was located by responding officers at Tulare/Noyes suffering from head injuries. It was discovered the same suspects had assaulted and robbed this victim of his wallet just prior to officers arriving. He was transported and admitted into a local hospital for the injuries, and is expected to recover. The two suspects, Ramon Dominguez and the male juvenile, were booked at the Tulare County Main Jail and Juvenile Hall, respectively, for Robbery, Resisting Arrests, and Conspiracy.
