Details: On listed date and time, Visalia Police Department officers responded to the Valley Fuel Get N Go in the 1900 block of S. Central Street for a reported shooting that just occurred. Officers were told several males exchanged words in the parking lot when one suspect fired multiple gunshots. No gunshot victims have been located. Officers were told the suspects fled in a vehicle prior to their arrival.

A description of the suspect vehicle was broadcast. A VPD detective located a vehicle matching the suspect vehicle description near Tulare and Court. A traffic stop was conducted at Tulare and Lovers Ln. and both male occupants were detained. After further investigation, both of these males have been arrested for this shooting. This incident appears to be gang related. Both suspects were booked at the Tulare County Pre Trail Facility for attempted homicide, shooting at a dwelling, and conspiracy.

One customer inside the store suffered minor injuries as he ran to escape the gunfire. The customer was transported to a local hospital where he was treated and released. *****UPDATE*****

During the ongoing investigation, a third suspect was identified as being involved in this incident. On 1/20/15 @ 1200 Hours, (S) Tomas Pizana (40 yoa) was arrested in the City of Visalia. He was subsequently booked for Attempted Homicide, Shooting at a Dwelling and conspiracy.

The incident was determined to be gang related.
