**Details:** On 7/1/15 at 1124 Hours, Visalia Police responded to a fight in progress call at Mary's Vineyard. Upon arrival, officers located a male victim suffering from head trauma as a result of the fight. The victim was transported to an area hospital. The victim's condition is stable at this time.

Witnesses on scene provided a description of two suspects who were involved in a fight with the victim. Detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit were called in to investigate the incident. During the course of the investigation, it was determined that the victim and suspects were acquaintances and had prior problems between them. When they inadvertently crossed paths at the location, a fight ensued. While Suspect Brodhurst was involved in a physical fight with the victim, Suspect Overstreet used a metal object to strike the victim over the head causing the serious injuries.

On 7/1/15 at 1530 Hours, Violent Crimes Detectives, with the assistance of the Youth Services Detectives, located both suspects hiding in the 700 Block of S. Goddard. Both suspects were arrested without incident. The weapon used in the incident was recovered. Both suspects were interviewed and later booked into Tulare County Jail for Attempted Homicide and Conspiracy.
