**Details:** On the listed date and time, Visalia Police Department officers responded to the area of NE 5th and Grape for reports of an injured male in the roadway. Upon arrival, officers found an adult male on NE 5<sup>th</sup> suffering from a gunshot wound. This male was taken to Kaweah Delta Medical Center for treatment. His injuries appear to be non-life threatening.

Violent Crimes detectives responded and took over the investigation. Detectives learned the injured male had previously entered the backyard of a home without permission in the 200 block of NE 5<sup>th</sup> where he was confronted by the homeowner of this residence. During this confrontation, the homeowner fired a handgun at the male striking him one time. The homeowner has been interviewed and is cooperating with detectives. No arrests have been made. The investigation is continuing.
