**Details:** On 03/07/2017 at 1031 hours, the Visalia Police Department's Narcotics Unit and Special Enforcement Unit served a narcotics related search warrant at a residence in the 300 block W. Grove in Visalia. The search warrant was the result of an on-going investigation of narcotic sales in and around the Lincoln Oval Park area. During the search, 9 individually wrapped packages of methamphetamine, additional packaging, digital scales, \$1900 cash, and a handgun were located. The resident, Leilani Aliya Salazar, was in possession of 18 MDMA pills. Salazar was booked at the Tulare County Jail for narcotic sales and firearm related charges.
