Details: On March 7, 2017 Visalia Department Narcotic and Special Enforcement Unit served a search warrant in the 300 block of W. Grove. There officers arrested Leilani Salazar for sales of illegal narcotics and illegal possession of a firearm. Information obtained during the service of that search warrant provided officers with further leads on the sale of illegal narcotics around the Lincoln Oval Park. On March 17, 2017 at 1430 hours, officers served a search warrant in the 600 block of E. Houston Ave. There officers located Alishia “Lisa” Seals, mother of Leilani Salazar, in possession of an ounce of Methamphetamine, 30 bindles of Heroin, \$2,019 in US currency, scales and packaging materials. Seals was arrested and booked into the Tulare County Jail on charges of possession of Methamphetamine for sale, possession of Heroin for sale, maintaining a place where narcotics are used or sold and a no bail warrant on other narcotic related charges.
