**Details:** On 6/5/2017 at approximately 1400hrs the Visalia Police Department responded to the area of Walnut/Chinowth to the report of a missing person. Upon arrival it was learned that Eunice Collins, 83, was not at her home, and had not been seen since Saturday 6/3. Officers were advised that she suffers from an illness requiring medication and that she does not have her medicine with her. Eunice Collins is described as a white female adult, approximately 5/6, 180 lbs, blonde shoulder length hair, wearing an unknown color shirt, blue jeans, black shoes, carrying a black purse and a bible. She does not drive and may be walking. Anyone with information or who may have seen Eunice Collins is encouraged to contact the Visalia Police Department at 734-8116. Detectives have continued the investigation into this missing person. On today's date at approximately 1440 hours, missing person Eunice Collins was located by detectives deceased along a canal bank in the 4200 block of W. Laura. The investigation is continuing however foul play is not suspected at this time.
