**Details:** On 7/22/17 at 0059 hours officers with the Visalia Police Department responded to a reported disturbance in the 200 blk of E. Main in downtown Visalia. While responded to the call officers learned that a subject had possibly been robbed by a subject armed with a handgun. Upon arrival in the area officers located the suspect who had a loaded handgun concealed on his person. The investigation revealed that the victim had been talking to the suspect, when the suspect demanded that he surrender his belongings. The victim was able to run from the scene and was pursued on foot by the suspect who abandoned his attempt to rob the victim. The suspect was arrested and booked in the Tulare County Adult Pre-trial Facility for numerous weapons charges, attempted robbery, and a criminal street gang enhancement.
