Details: ON LISTED DATE AND TIME OFFICERS RESPONDED TO KOHL'S FOR A ROBBERY INVOLVING THE LISTED SUSPECTS. BOTH SUSPECTS WERE OBSERVED LEAVING KOHL'S WITHOUT PAYING FOR MISC. ITEMS AND WHEN THEY WERE STOPPED BY A KOHL'S LOSS PREVENTION OFFICER THE FEMALE SUSPECT USED A CHEMICAL AGENT, AGAINST THE LOSS PREVENTION OFFICER, AND BOTH SUSPECTS FLED WITH THE STOLEN ITEMS.

ON 9/22/17 AT 2115 HOURS PATROL OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A DISTURBANCE AT WAL-MART (1819 E. NOBLE). UPON ARRIVAL THE LISTED SUSPECTS WERE CONTACTED. THE SUBSEQUENT INVESTIGATION SHOWED THEM TO BE THE SUSPECTS FROM THE KOHL'S ROBBERY AND THEY WERE BOTH ARRESTED FOR ARMED ROBBERY, CONSPIRACY, AND SEVERAL DRUG AND WEAPONS CHARGES. BOTH SUSPECTS WERE TRANSPORTED TO AND BOOKED AT THE TULARE COUNTY PRE TRIAL FACILITY
