**Details:** On 10/10/17 at 1205 hours, several witnesses called 911 reporting a subject had fired a handgun into the air at Court/Paradise. The witnesses provided a description of the suspect and his direction of travel. An officer assigned to the VPD Special Enforcement Unit located the suspect, identified as Robert Crossley, on Garden south of Tulare in a vehicle. A loaded, stolen handgun was located in the vehicle. Crossley was identified by witnesses as the subject who had fired the handgun into the air.

Crossley was arrested without incident and booked at the Tulare County Jail for several firearm related charges including Negligent Discharge of a Firearm.
