Details: On 1/5/18 at 0915 hours members of the Visalia Police Department Narcotics Unit and Special Enforcement Unit served a search warrant in the 400 block of N.E. Second Ave. in Visalia. While serving the search warrant, officers located Methamphetamine, scales and packaging materials. Officers also discovered that there were 5 children living in the house ranging in age from 2 to 13. Officers arrested the suspects on the following charges:

Eddie Garcia was arrested for possession of Methamphetamine for sale
Suspects Miguel Lopez and Carlos Lopez were arrested for Child Endangerment because they allowed narcotics to be brought into the residence and sold from the residence.
