**Details:** On 2/19/18 at approximately 0335 hours officers with the Visalia Police Department were on patrol in the area of Blain Park in the City of Visalia. While in the area officers observed a suspicious vehicle. Upon seeing the officers the driver attempted to flee the area at which time a traffic stop was attempted.
