Details: On February 26, 2018, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 p.m., Visalia Police Officers conducted a minor decoy operation. During the six hour detail, an underage decoy was sent into numerous ABC licensed establishments and attempted to purchase alcoholic beverages. The underage decoy was able to purchase alcohol at one of the locations visited. Walgreens sold an alcoholic beverage to the underage decoy and will face an administrative review by ABC, the business could face a fine or a suspension of their alcohol license. The Visalia Police Department urges all licensed establishments to carefully check the ID's of all individuals who appear to be younger than 30 years of age.
