Details: On 7/8/18 at approximately 0036 hour the Visalia Police Department received a call of an assault with a deadly weapon in the 200 block of E. Main Street. During the investigation officers learned that a verbal altercation broke out between two parties. At some point during the confrontation the suspect produced a handgun and shot the victim. . During a search of the downtown area officers located that suspected shooter near Santa Fe and Center where he was detained without incident. He was identified as 18 year old Robert Crossley of Visalia. Additionally the suspected firearm used in the incident was recovered near the scene. The victim was transported to KDMC where he was treated for a non-life threatening gunshot wound. The suspect was transported to the Tulare County Pre-trial Facility where he was booked for attempted murder and numerous firearms related charges.
