**Details:** On 6/15/18 at 1730 hours, VPD’s Special Enforcement Unit located an occupied stolen vehicle in the city of Exeter. A traffic stop was initiated, but the vehicle failed to yield. The pursuit was terminated after a short distance due to public safety concerns. The vehicle fled westbound out of the city of Exeter. At 1750 hours, the SEU officers located the stolen vehicle unoccupied on the southeast corner of Caldwell/Demaree in the city of Visalia. The two suspects were seen walking eastbound on the northside of Caldwell. Jaron Hirsch, who was identified as the driver, fled on foot, but was caught attempting to cross Caldwell. Ricky Flynn was apprehended without incident. Jaron Hirsch was arrested for felony evading, possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of stolen property, and resisting arrest. Ricky Flynn was arrested for possession of stolen property and a parole violation.
