**Details:** On 07-10-18 at 2:15 p.m., the Visalia Police Department’s Special Enforcement Unit (SEU) stopped a vehicle in the area of Linwood and Noble for a traffic violation. Upon further investigation during the stop, a ¼ pound of methamphetamine was found in the vehicle. The listed Suspect Jeffrey Martin Nunez was taken into custody without incident.

At 6:01 p.m., the Visalia Police Department’s Narcotic’s Unit, SEU and with the assistance of the Kings County Narcotic's Task Force, a search warrant was served at Nunez’s residence in Lemoore. A small amount of methamphetamine and \$6,300.00 in U.S. currency was located and seized.

Nunez was transported and booked at the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility for possession of methamphetamine for sale and for transportation of methamphetamine for sale.
