Details: On the listed date and time, patrol officers located a Ram pick-up truck involved in an exhibition of speed and driving recklessly. They attempted a stop on the vehicle and it failed to yield. A pursuit was initiated, however, the pursuit was terminated due to excessive speed and numerous vehicle code violations. A short time later, another officer, conducting a neighborhood check near the last known location of the vehicle, located it in the front yard of a residence near the listed location. The vehicle had a minor collision with the residence. Officers located S- Tyrone Moore hiding in the bushes across the street from the scene of the collision. Officers looked in the bed of the pick-up truck and noticed two large trash bags filled with approximately 20 pounds of processed marijuana. They also located more than \$7,800 in the vehicle. S- Moore was arrested and booked on the listed charges. No injuries were reported and the residence only received minor cosmetic damage.
