Details: On the listed date and time, Visalia Police Department officers responded to a family disturbance in the 1000 block of N. Willis. Upon arrival, officers were told 22 year old Christopher Limon-Luna was under the influence of a controlled substance, vandalizing property, and had assaulted his mother. Officers also learned Limon-Luna had several outstanding arrest warrants.

Officers contacted Limon-Luna at the home and began speaking with him. Limon-Luna was extremely agitated and holding his infant child. Officers gave Limon-Luna multiple orders to release his child and surrender but he refused and attempted to barricade himself within the residence. Limon-Luna later exited the residence still holding his child and attempted to push past officers.

Officers attempted to arrest Limon-Luna but he resisted. Officers were able to remove the child from the suspect. Limon-Luna was taken to the ground and continued to resist arrest and assaulted a police K9. Officers were able to eventually take the suspect into custody with the assistance of the police K9. The suspect was later booked into the Tulare County Pre Trial Facility for numerous charges including child endangerment, under the influence of a controlled substance, assaulting a police K9, resisting arrest, and the arrest warrants. The child was unharmed and returned to family.
