**Details:** On 8-2-19 in the afternoon hours, officers responded to a residence in Visalia regarding a family disturbance. Upon arrival officers learned Jaime Davila-Mariscal struck his girlfriend causing injury, and threatened to shoot her during the incident. Officers were also advised Davila-Mariscal was known to carry a firearm on his person. Davila-Mariscal fled the residence prior to arrival of the police. At about 9:07 PM, the victim used the texting feature on her cellular phone to call "911" to alert dispatch that the suspect was currently at the residence again. Officers with the Special Enforcement Bureau and Patrol Division converged on a residence in the 800 block of N. Divisadero in an effort to arrest Davila-Mariscal. When officers approached, Davila-Mariscal fled from the residence on foot. A perimeter was established and a police K-9 was used to search yard to yard. A short time later the police K-9 located Davila-Mariscal hiding behind debris in the backyard of a nearby residence. Davila-Mariscal was taken into custody and transported to a local hospital for treatment. After treatment, Davila-Mariscal will be booked at the Adult Pre-Trial Facility for Domestic Violence, Criminal Threats and Resisting Arrest.
