**Details:** On February 23rd, 2020 at approximately 2138 hours the Visalia Police Department responded to a residence in the 4300 block of W. Cambridge Ave in the City of Visalia for a report of a shooting into an occupied dwelling. Upon arrival officers discovered that an unknown suspect fired a round at the victim residence and fled prior to the arrival of officers. Further investigation also revealed that earlier in the day an unknown suspect had placed an explosive device outside of the residence which was still on scene. A member of the Tulare County Consolidated Bomb Squad responded and rendered the device safe. The investigation into this incident is ongoing.
