Details: On 3/4/20 at 0630 patrol responded to a grand theft call in the 1200 block of N. Cato St. A photo of the suspect was shown to members of the VPD Homeless Outreach and Proactive Enforcement Team (HOPE) and the suspect was positively identified as Jordan Burriel. On 3/4/20 at 1100 hours, Burriel was located along the St. Johns River east of Lark and taken into custody by the HOPE Team and turned over to VPD Property Crimes to complete the investigation. Burriel had in his possession 14 grams of methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia, burglary tools and a modified replica firearm. He was transported and booked into the Tulare County Pre-Trial facility for the following charges: Possession of Narcotics, Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia, Grand Theft, Possession of Burglary Tools, Providing False Information to a Peace Officer, Modifying a Replica Firearm, and Possession of Narcotics in a Drug Free Zone.
