**Details:** On March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 the Visalia Police Department received a report regarding a commercial burglary which occurred at Yoshinoya Restaurant on Mooney Blvd. The incident was captured on the businesses surveillance system. The suspect was identified as Jordan McKnight by members of the VPD Homeless Outreach and Proactive Enforcement Team (HOPE). On March 25<sup>th</sup> members of the VPD Property Crimes Unit and HOPE Team located McKnight along the St. Johns River and took him into custody. McKnight was also in possession of a concealed dagger, methamphetamine, and drug paraphernalia. McKnight was booked into the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility.
