**Details:**

On June 13, 2020 at 12:35 PM, Visalia Police Department received a 911 call in regards to a subject, Roberto Hernandez, who was believed to be under the influence of a controlled substance. While armed with 2 loaded firearms, in the presence of his 3 small children, he made criminal threats and fled the residence prior to Officers arrival.

During the investigation, officers located Hernandez' vehicle in the 2100 block of North Mora Court at a family member's residence. Officers were able to establish communication with Hernandez by phone and he refused to come out. Through negotiations, Hernandez exited the residence and was taken into custody by awaiting officers. Two (2) loaded firearms were located hidden in the yard. He was booked at Tulare County Adult Pretrial Facility.
