Details: On 5-27-21 at approximately 1942 hours, Patrol officers responded to 3615 W. Noble Ave. (Save Mart) for a report of a man with a gun. Prior to officer's arrival, the Victim was in the parking lot of Save Mart when the Victim was approached by three subjects. The three subjects were later identified as Suspect Julio Jacobo, Suspect Andrew Remigio, and Suspect Male Juvenile. The three Suspects confronted the Victim, threatened the victim, made gang related remarks, and brandished a firearm at the Victim. Suspect Jacobo, Suspect Remigio, and Suspect Male Juvenile then left the scene in a brown colored SUV. The Victim was able to follow the suspect vehicle at a safe distance and called 911 where he provided the direction of travel for the suspect vehicle. An officer located the suspect vehicle in the area of Court St. and Noble Ave and a traffic stop was conducted. During the investigation of the traffic stop, a loaded firearm was found in the vehicle and all three Suspects were placed under arrest. Suspect Male Juvenile was later transported to the Tulare County Juvenile Detention Facility where he was booked for brandishing a firearm and conspiracy. Suspect Remigio and Suspect Jacobo were later booked into the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility. Suspect Remigio was booked for brandishing of a firearm, conspiracy, and gang enhancement. Suspect Jacobo was booked for brandishing of a firearm, conspiracy, gang enhancement, possession of a loaded firearm in public, carrying a concealed firearm in a vehicle, and possession of an unregistered firearm.
