Details: On 10/28/21 at 4:27 PM, patrol responded to a stabbing on the 1000 block of W. Goshen. Patrol officers arrived on scene and located Suspect Moore outside his apartment. Suspect Moore was taken into custody without incident. The victim was transported to Kaweah Health Medical Center and is listed in stable condition.

During the investigation, officers learned two neighbors were involved in a dispute over a parking spot. During the dispute, Suspect Moore produced a knife and stabbed the victim. Suspect Moore was transported and booked into the Tulare County Pre-Trial facility for PC 245 – Assault with a Deadly Weapon.

The Visalia Police Department Violent Crimes Unit and Crime Lab were called out to assist with this ongoing investigation.
