**Details:** On 3-31-22 at 11:19 a.m., officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of West Cambridge regarding a shooting that had just occurred. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male victim suffering from a gunshot wound to the hip area. Officers learned that the victim was riding a bicycle westbound on Cambridge when a vehicle drove up next to the victim and fired one shot, striking the victim.

The victim was transported to Kaweah Health Medical Center for treatment. His condition is not known at this time. The Violent Crimes Unit was called out to take over the investigation.
