Details: On June 20, 2022, at 7:15 pm, Visalia Police Department Officers responded to the 3700 block of E. Paradise regarding a shots fired call for service. Several residents in the area reported hearing 4-5 gunshots. Upon arrival, officers were directed to a home where a disturbance was heard between a male and female. Contact was made with the female homeowner however numerous attempts to contact the male inside the residence identified as 38-year-old Brandon Baumanns were unsuccessful and he remained inside.

At approximately 8:46 pm, Brandon Baumanns did make contact with officers, and he was subsequently taken into custody. A search of the home revealed a semi-automatic handgun and ammunition. Several empty shell casings were also located in the backyard of the residence. Brandon Baumanns was booked into the Tulare County Pre Trial-Facility for negligent discharge of a firearm.
