Visalia, Calif. – The Visalia Police Department conducted a DUI Saturation Patrol August 12, 2022. During the detail officers conducted 47 enforcement stops, arrested 2 drivers on suspicion of DUI and issued 44 traffic citations.

We are committed to taking impaired drivers off the road,” Sgt. Greg Byerlee said. “Driving under the influence is not only dangerous, but also has major consequences.”

Drivers charged with a first-time DUI face an average of \$13,500 in fines and penalties, as well as a suspended license.

The Visalia Police Department will be holding a series of DUI enforcement patrols throughout the year to keep our roadways safe.
