VPD Holding DUI Checkpoint TOMORROW

This Friday, June 16, 2023, the Visalia Police Department will conduct a Driving Under the Influence (DUI) and Driver's License (DL) checkpoint in the City of Visalia.

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on data showing incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints is to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off the road.

"Impaired drivers put others on the road at significant risk," Officer Alex Sabo said. "Any prevention measures that reduce the number of impaired drivers on our roads significantly improves traffic safety."

The Visalia Police Department would like to remind the public that impaired driving is not just from alcohol. Some prescription medications and over-the-counter drugs may interfere with driving. While medical and recreational marijuana are legal, driving under the influence of marijuana is ILLEGAL.

Drivers charged with a first-time DUI face an average of \$13,500 in fines and penalties, as well as a suspended license.
