UPDATE: VPD Traffic Unit Investigating Major Injury Pedestrian Collision on Demaree Street and Walnut Avenue

At 2:06 p.m. today, Visalia PD officers responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian collision at the intersection of Demaree Street and Walnut Avenue. The pedestrian, a 22-year-old man, sustained major injuries and was transported to Kaweah Health. The driver of the vehicle remained at the scene and is cooperating fully with law enforcement.

The Visalia PD Traffic Unit responded to the scene and is currently investigating the collision. Drugs or alcohol do not appear to be a factor in the collision.
