**Visalia PD to Conduct DUI Checkpoint Tonight**

The Visalia Police Department will be conducting a Driving Under the Influence (DUI) and Driver's License (DL) checkpoint tonight. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints is to deter impaired driving, promote public safety, and remove intoxicated drivers from the road. In addition to DUI enforcement, officers will also be checking for valid driver's licenses.

DUI checkpoints are a critical tool in reducing the number of alcohol- and drug-related traffic collisions, which can result in serious injuries and fatalities. By identifying impaired drivers and unlicensed motorists, the Visalia Police Department aims to make the streets safer for everyone.

This operation is funded by the California Highway Patrol's Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program.
