**Arrests Made in Visalia After Search Warrant Uncovers Ghost Gun and Drug Offenses**

This morning at 8:30 a.m., Visalia Police Department's Narcotics and Special Enforcement Unit (SEU), along with the Tulare County Agencies Regional Gun Enforcement Team (TARGET), served a search warrant at a home in the 300 block of NW 4th Street in Visalia.

During the search, 21-year-old Andrew Remigo was found with a privately manufactured short-barreled rifle, also known as a "ghost gun," and high-capacity magazines. 25-year-old Abel Remigo was discovered in possession of marijuana with the intent to distribute while caring for a small child.

Andrew Remigo was arrested on charges of possessing an assault weapon, an undetectable firearm, and criminal storage of a firearm. Abel Remigo and 26-year-old Caressa Castro were arrested for child endangerment. Abel faces additional charges related to marijuana sales.
